Hi max. This is Andres from the mayor's office. I'd like to set up a regular meeting with you. Ivy will join. I will ask Susanna to reach out. I will say that your media engagement is concerning.

Hi Andres. Thanks for reaching out. I will just highlight a couple things I mentioned to Ivy.

1. First and foremost, I am very happy to follow whatever process the Mayor's office wants me to follow. But it was definitely not clear to me that i should be giving a heads each time i speak to a reporter.

2. This is especially true because everything i said or wrote i have previously said many, many times, directly to the mayor, to the mayor's staff, and publicly in commission meetings, and no one has ever indicated that i should not be saying those things.

3. I also assumed that the mayors office would not necessarily want to be bothered w an update each time a reporter reaches out to me given how frequently that occurs (not just me, but multiplied by all the mayor appointed commissioners).

4. As for the Time piece, they let me know yesterday late afternoon that they were accepting it and it was published today so i also didnt have a ton of heads up.

5. Finally, i'll just stress that in all my reporter convos i emphasize that this is a team effort and that im working collaboratively with the dept and dpa (as i did at tonight's meeting). But it never makes the cut in articles. I talk to a reporter for 20min and they pick 2 sentences to print.

I don't do this via text. We can discuss by phone. Now or tomorrow at 11. Which is better?

Hi Andres, I just wanted to follow up on our discussion to let you know that I won't be able to make a statement along the lines of what you proposed for 2 reasons. First, it's untrue. Thanks to HRC's hard work, there will be a robust community engagement process. And second, the call to postpone the listening sessions has never been about concern for community, its always been sfpd's attempt to delay the dgo process. A dgo, i might add, that they signed off on before I introduced it (both verbally and over email) to then only go behind my back and complain to you that they were "ambushed" by its introduction.

I mean to say delay the working groups, not the listening sessions

Ok. It's unfortunate that you are caving to politics instead of honestly listening to community.

I think my decision is the opposite of caving to politics. I'm doing what I think is right, and refusing to say something that I know is untrue.

While I regret the tone that you took with me on our call (is it really necessary to say that it's beneath you to even debate me?), I remain open and willing to working with the Mayor's office on issues as they arise. But I simply cannot make a public statement like this which I know to be false.
